Flatland Gamers Third Annual Game Fair and Convention

REGINA - The Flatland Regional Association of Gamers (FRAG) is pleased to present the *2007 Flatland Fantasy Game Fair and Convention*. This third annual event will be held on April 27, 28, and 29 at the Regina Senior Citizens Centre, 2134 Winnipeg Street, Regina. The Convention is a celebration of all kinds of non-electronic gaming: role-playing (both sit down and live action), board gaming (traditional and European designs), miniatures gaming (fantasy, science fiction, and historical), and card gaming (both collectible and stand alone).

In addition, this year will also see a Miniatures Painting competition where attendees can show off their painting skills, and a Flea Market area where attendees will have a chance to sell or trade used games, books, and accessories.

Admission for the entire Weekend is \$30. Day passes are also available: Friday - \$10, Saturday - \$20, and Sunday - \$15. Family and bulk discounts are also available.

People of all ages are invited to come and play in one of the many tournaments or demonstration games. Tournaments are planned for the following games: *Dungeons & Dragons* role-playing, *Warhammer Fantasy* and *Warhammer 40,000* miniatures, *Star Wars* miniatures, the *Settlers of Catan* board game, the *Pirates of the Spanish Main* collectible card game, a *World of Darkness* LARP (Live Action Role-Play), the *Tichu* card game, as well as other board games (including whole days devoted to the play of games published by Rio Grande Games and Mayfair Games). Many other demonstrations and pick-up games will be showcased throughout the weekend.

Come see what we do as members of the Flatland Gamers and participate in the games we play. According to one of our members, "They aren't games... they're Mensa-Membership-Training-Accessories!"

Local sponsors include Comicreaders (downtown Regina), Tramp's (Regina), Games Workshop (Southland Mall), and Affinity's Antiques. These local game shops support the Convention and provide immeasurable help in running events and provide prize support. Additional support is also provided by many game manufacturers and distributors.

Door prizes and draws will be held throughout each day for a number of games and game accessories.
